He appeared in the census in 1841 in 20, Wenlock Road, Tower Hamlet, Shoreditch, London.. In 1841 Henry was in P (Pension ?) (Age 70) - (Retired Police Officer). He died on 25 Feb 1842 at the age of 73 in St. Lukes (1Q1842-2-200)(73). He lived in Phiswell Street, St. Lukes (PR) on 3 Mar 1842. Henry was buried on 3 Mar 1842 in St. Johns The Baptist, Hoxton, Hackney (73)(PR). **Note - Found the marriage to Sarah Pultney or Pulton on Family History on Line some years ago. See Records Found. He could be Henry Vickery Turnpenny ?**

Henry & Frances were witness to the marriage of John Ramsey & Hannah Jones on 18-5-1823 at St. Mary le Bowe.

Briefly says that he was formerly of Edmunds Place, Aldergate Street,In the City of London, late an officer in the City Police, now of Wenlock Road, Gentleman.

People mentioned in his will :- Henry (son), Thomas (son) Frances Hannah Carr (dau), & Mary Turner (sister) plus others who are none family members.

Also note that the Witness to the will was Henry Colebrook & Richard Wright who were his neighbours living in Wenlock Road.

He is dscribed as a Gentleman of Bartholemew Close, late Officer in the City Police. Formerly of Wenlock Road, CityRoad - Artillery Court, Chiswell Street & Edmunds Place, Aldergate Street, City of London

Is it possible that there was another Henry in this family who died in infancy and buried 2nd Oct 1795 in St Martins, Birmingham.

Henry Turnpenny and Sarah Pultney were married on 18 Jun 1786 in Handsworth, Birmingham.. Cannot find where I obtained this information from but think I may have obtained it from the Walsall Family History Centre. **Sarah Pultney** was born about 1766. She died before 1808 at the age of 42. **Could be Sarah Pulton**

On 16 Jul 1838 he was in Musician - Shown on sons marriage certificate.¹ In 1841-1871 he was in Musician. Henry appeared in the census in 1841 in James Street, Finsbury, London. (Parish of St. Luke). In 1844 he was in Musician (St Leonards, Shoreditch)(PR). He lived in Dodsley's Folly (PR) in 1844. Henry lived in Red Lion Street - PR in 1845. He appeared in the census in 1851 in 17, Garden Walk, St. Leonards, Shoreditch.. He appeared in the census in 1861 in 44, Little Hillbow Street, Middlesex. Henry appeared in the census in 1871 in 4, Barton Close, St. Leonards, Shoreditch.. He died in 1871 at the age of 78 in Shorditch (4Q1871-1c128)(77). **Note. There was a Henry son of Henry and Sarah buried on 2nd October 1795 at St. Martin in Birmingham, but no age given. Was this another Henry ? Consequently we may have the wrong parents of this Henry.**

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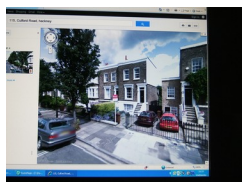

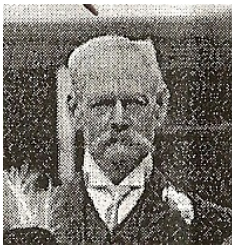

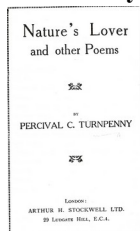

History of the League of Mercy.

The League of Mercy was founded on 30th of March 1899 by Royal Charter of Queen Victoria. It was instigated by the Prince of Wales who became its first Grand President. Subsequently two further Prince of Wales (George v and Edward v111) succeeded him in this office; finally HRH Prince Henry, Duke of Gloucester took over.

The object of the League was to establish a large body of voluntary workers who would assist with the maintenance of voluntary hospitals and " otherwise relieve sickness and suffering". When the 1948 National Health Act abolished these hospitals, the League was quietly wound up after performing its task extraordinarily well for nearly half a century.

Central to the annual activities of the League was a notable ceremony at which about fifty people each received a medal known as the Order of Mercy. These were bestowed as a reward for personal services gratuitously rendered in connection with the purposes for which the league was established. The League of Mercy was re-founded as a UK registered on the 30th of March 1999, exactly one hundred years to the day after its first establishment.

Then there was some trouble with permanent residents taking up to many rooms and she moved to another hotel nearby. She had a small room and 90% of her things were in store at Harrods. Her nephew remembers going with her once to change her wardrobe from one season to another and it was all very distressing. It was a turmoil with shoes and things on the floor not properly packed. Some time in early 1983 her nephew again visited her in a Catholic Home (which would later become clear was for destitute & homeless people) living in a convent room and it was pretty grim. A few months latter they had a letter from the convent to say she had died penniless, and she had been to proud to say and now know why she was in that awful place. Apparently a man had befriended her, somebody she met at a cafe and tried to help her. The council wanted to put her in a paupers grave but now the family had found out they clubbed together and they paid for the burial at Putney Vale with her husband. Her Beautiful engagement ring and other jewelery were worthless fakes. A few years before Garrads had made cheap copies for her.

Good bye Lily, our oldest "boy"

Lily Turnpenny, Dovers oldest resident, died last week aged 108. Her son John who cared for her at their Park Avenue home for many years. said "My mother slipped peacefully away on Sunday morning." She

died at Kearsney Manor Nursing Home where she had been living for several months.

Born in Limerick, Mrs Turnpenny came to Dover in 1897 when her father John Vass was appointed agent for the Clyde Shipping Company at the expanding port.

She gained a scholarship to the girls section of the newly created Dover County School in 1905 and five years later joined the co-educational sixth form at the County School for Boys in Ladywell.

"Six of us were selected for this sixth form but during that year an edict came from Kent County Council that no more girls would be allowed to join the boys at Ladywell. Those who were there could stay , one other girl stayed with me but only for one term, so I carried on with the boys" recalled Mrs Turnpenny two years ago.

"We were told the boys and girls in the sixth form could sit next to each other but if we met in the street we must not stop and talk," she said. Mrs Turnpenny is believed to be the first girl from the school to win a scholarship to go to Bedford College for

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Women, part of the University of London, to read English.

That was in 1912 and she graduated in 1915. Because of her time at Dover County (now grammar) School for Boys she was always regarded as the schools oldest "old boy". She was a member of the Old Pharosians Association.

Lily worked in a bank in Dover, and later in London, until she married local businessman Sidney Turnpenny (who died in 1975) in 1919, they had a daughter and a son. During the 1939-1945 war she helped out at Dover food office issuing ration books, and assisting in the family furniture business.

Mrs Turnpenny was a vice-president of Dover Operatic and Dramatic Society and supported a number of other local organisations. Her son John, a few days before she died, read to her extracts from the Old Pharosians newsletter just published.

Lilian TURNPENNY has died at the age of 108, at Kearsney Manor Nursing Home on Sunday. Her son John said he believed she was the oldest person in the County of Kent.

Mrs TURNPENNY had lived in Dover for over 100 years and attended the Dover County school (later to become the Boys Grammar). She had a degree from Bedford College, London, and married Sydney TURNPENNY of the Dover furniture company in London Road, and had two children, John (now 78) and Suzanne three years older. Comm stands for command and War Subs would have been War Substantive (rank) although it is

a bit of contradiction in terms as it was only atemporary wartime rank.
