Whereas the acting Commissioners in the commission of Bankrupt awarded against John Turnpenny, now or late of the City of Gloucester, Coach Maker have certified to the Right Hon, Henry Earl Bathurst, lord High Chancellor of Great Britain, that the said John Turnpenny hath informed according to the Directions of the several Acts of Parliament made concerning Bankrupts; This is to give notice, that, by Virtue of an Act passed in the Fifth Year of His late Majesty's Reign, his certificate will be allowed and confirmed on or before the 24th Day of February instant.

Frederick C Turnpenny and Lydia E Ellicott were married about 1837 in Baltimore, Maryland, USA. Lydia E Ellicott, daughter of Ellicott, was born in 1811 in Maryland, Pennsylvania, USA (C1880 says born 1815). She appeared in the census in 1880 in United States Federal Census - Philadelphia, Pennylvania - (Need to get from Ancestry). On her death certificate says single ! but she had been a widow for 47 years.

1867 - Pennsylvania Hospital Records, 800, Spruce Street, Philadelphia. Joseph C Turnpenny was listed among others for collecting money for the hospital.
